DESCRIPTIONS OF GLORY TO GLORY CONFERENCE 2011 ACTIVITIES

Check In and Registration- When you arrive at the Marriott Hotel, your group leader/contact person will come in to the registration table and obtain badges, programs, and T-shirts for the group. Maps will be provided for entertainment, restaurants, etc. When you have the conference information, your leader will check you into your room or provide you a place to wait until the opening activities begin. Please wear name badges at all times and to all events.

Registration Pick-Up for Delegates Not Staying in the Hotel- Plan to arrive at the hotel by 5:00 p.m. so that the contact person/group leader can pick up the badges, programs, and T-shirts for the group. Your leader will determine where your group will remain until Pep Radical begins. Please wear name badges at all times and to all events. The first activity will begin at 6:00 p.m. and the welcome program will end by 9:45 p.m. Be sure that all of your group have ways to get home.

Pep Radical- Get your loud voice ready! Let your cheerleaders lead your group as the Pep Radicals take to the stage in the Main Ballroom for an hour of songs, cheers, chants, steps, and friendly church competitions. You may want to show off your church T-shirts, or your church posters you made, or even your church flag (see more on this further down)! Young and Seasoned folk participate in this mixer!

Welcome Program & Choir Night- The Mayor and other dignitaries will welcome you to the city (with brief greetings). Then, you will be blessed as famous choirs from throughout the state minister to your heart and mind. You will sing, clap, and truly give **God** the glory on Choir Night.

Nehemiah Prayer Time/Morning Worship- Come and get in God's presence as we petition our Lord in individual and corporate prayer. Counselors are present to pray with and for you during this time. The morning worship brings everyone together as we praise **God**, lift **Him** up, and be motivated by awesome speakers.

Conference Classes- People from two (2) to ninety-two (92) will find classes to meet their needs. Anointed teachers will give you what God has given to them concerning our topics. You will have an opportunity to ask questions, role play, and interact with others in your age group.

Break Times: Churches can use this time to plan your group's individual activities and excursions in the Baton Rouge area. Many businesses have given special discounts on entertainment; be sure you let them know you are from Glory to Glory.

Bible Bowl- Will the trophy come to your church? Your state? Piney Grove Missionary Baptist Church in Tuscaloosa, Alabama won the first Bible Bowl. Have your church enter a team to compete. Guidelines and information will be sent your way to help you study for the competition.

Liturgical Dance Presentations- Churches are invited to have their dance ministry share their praise dances with the conference. Stomps and Mime are also acceptable. This is not a competition but a time of giving praise through dance to our Lord.

Late Night Service- After the day's activities are over, come and listen to one of the mighty Men/Women of God. The service is in the Main Ballroom and lasts for one hour.

Rap Sessions- Do you have a burning question? What do others think about how you feel and what you believe? Listen to your peers as they talk with you and others about the topics. You might be surprised to find some special guests sharing with us.

First Ladies' Tea- Every pastor's wife is invited to come to this special fellowship. Lady Litt and her team put together an afternoon that you won't soon forget. There are special surprises for the women of **God** who are helping the Angel of each house to stand.

Sports Tournament Day- Put your game face on! Basketball, volleyball, and flag football teams will 'compete' in an afternoon of fun and exercise. Medals are given to everyone who participates. We pray together and we play together.

President's Banquet- Dr. Litt will honor the Glory to Glory Advisory Board and Sister Mable Charles as we remember "The Father of Glory to Glory," Elder Albert Charles. This is a dress-up time. Tickets are \$40.00 per person. Plan now to support your pastor and other board members as they are acknowledged for their hard work.

Jammin for Jesus- While adults are attending the banquet, children and youth will attend this activity. Games, dancing, prizes, praising will be just a small part of the activities that night. Children under eight (8 yrs) must be accompanied by an adult or a chaperone.

Flag Day- Each church is invited to make a flag. Your flag must be 2 yards x 2 yards. Material may be broadcloth or lightweight lining fabric. You are to decorate your flag using your church motto, theme, or items representative of your church family. You may get a pole from Home Depot or Lowe's. The edging and/or decorations are up to your flag committee.
